

Access to the University of Bolton Library Resources

The University of Bolton signed a memorandum of understanding with Bolton U3A in October 2018. As part of that agreement, the University provides U3A members with use of the Library for reference and research purposes.

The Library will provide access to:


- bookstock and audio-visual material
- print journals
- reference material
- photocopying facilities
- open access and quiet study space.

U3A members can make use of library resources on a **reference-only basis**. Please note that borrowing is not currently permitted.

Access to computing software, online resources and group study rooms is not permitted.

How to Apply

2. Take the completed application form and your U3A membership card to the Help Desk at the University of Bolton Library during staffed opening hours. You will be issued with a University of Bolton Library card which will allow you reference access to the Library. We will require proof of your U3A membership.

Please note. The Library may not be able to process applications at very

busy times, particularly the beginning of semesters.

Other Details

- Membership of the scheme expires annually and can only be renewed on presentation of a valid U3A membership card.
- All users will be expected to observe relevant regulations that apply to studying in the Library. Your card can be withdrawn if you infringe the rules of the University of Bolton Library.

You must have your University of Bolton Library card with you when you visit.
